This Sunday

This Sunday, January 24, we hear Jesus on the shore of the Sea of Galilee saying to the initial disciples, "Follow me."

That text will be used to wrestle with a question posed by the winner of the First Parish Auction during the "Wreaths and More ..." Christmas Fair. The "winner" asked for a sermon on "how does one know" God's call for one's life.



In consultation with our finalist, we looked at the lectionary texts for this winter and spring and thought this text with the disciples responding "*immediately*" may be revelatory. From the text, we do not know if these fishermen had ever met Jesus or not. Jesus certainly did not yet have a reputation as a teacher or healer or miracle worker or as one raised from humiliation, suffering, and death; so, *how did they know* to follow?
